WILD CARD SELECTIONS

Depending on the number of applications received, the Selection Committee has broad authority to grant acceptance to Team USA to fill the remaining Team from the list of applicants who have submitted a regatta application form to the US I-420 Class office prior to the applications deadline.

If you wish to be considered for a Wild Card spot on Team USA, please provide a brief description of your relevant background that you would like to the Selection Committee to consider with your application (you do not need to list results of any I420 qualifying regattas you may have attended, nor qualification points earned - the Selection committee already has this information).

Note: Prior I420 International experience is an important factor in selecting “Wild Card” teams. Teams without experience at any of the I420 qualifying regattas will be considered for selection as a “Wild Card” team if it is deemed by the US I420 Class Selection Committee and the Associations Head Coach that the sailors have sufficient prior experience (in the I420 class or other classes) that would indicate that the Team is prepared to be competitive.

While qualification points accumulated at I420 Qualifying Points Regattas by a sailor are important in the final decision as to which sailors will be chosen by the Selection Committee to compete on any championship team (Team USA), qualification points are not the only criteria. A sailor’s practice of appropriate Corinthian spirit, sportsmanship and general behavior are an important component of the final selection process. Sailors with a history of inappropriate behavior on and/or off the race course can affect the decision of the Selection Committee to accept or reject a sailor’s application to compete on any Team USA team at any championship event.

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
