Team USA – SAILOR CONTRACT

Form must be signed by sailors and also parents if sailor is under 21 years of age

The undersigned persons (sailors and parents) do hereby acknowledge by their signatures that accepting the invitation to sail as part of Team USA means the sailors agree to abide by all the rules, regulations, information as published in the Sailing Instructions of the event, and the Regatta Notice of Race, with special attention to sections regarding Disclaimer, Safety Regulations, Random Drug Testing, and any and all instructions of the Race Committee and the Jury regarding the event as may be found in the SI's and the NOR or as published during the regatta, and other rules established by the Team Manager and Coaches – including but not limited to - the sailors of Team USA shall adhere to the drinking age restrictions of the United States (age 21) no matter what the local laws of the country of the event, and agree that the consumption of Alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited during the entire event.

The undersigned further acknowledge and affirm that they understand that they are representing the United States of America, Team USA, their individual Yacht & Sailing Clubs as well as their families and themselves at this event, and that their behavior is a direct reflection onto themselves and the other extended parties. Additionally, the undersigned agrees to abide by the civil and criminal laws of the Countries that the Team may be visiting.

The undersigned also acknowledges and agrees that in the event the sailor is deemed by the manager, coaches or chaperones to be a danger to themselves or others; that the actions of the sailor are not in keeping with proper Corinthian behavior, or that the sailor has demonstrated a pattern of behavior that is harmful, reckless, dangerous, unlawful, abusive or disrespectful of the authority of Team USA, the host country, the event sponsor, law enforcement and others, that at his sole discretion the Team Manager, Lead Coach or designated Chaperone may withdraw the sailor(s) from the competition, and may, if deemed necessary, send the skipper(s) and crew(s) back to the United States as soon as is practicably possible.

The manager, coaches and chaperones do not serve as child care for the Team Members, and expect that all Team Members will act in a responsible, law-abiding manner at all times, on and off the race course. The sailors and parents both acknowledge that the directions of the manager must be adhered to for the entire duration of the event, and that the sailors must keep the manager, coaches and chaperones aware of their location and activities at all times.
